In 2017, the founder and former Executive Director of A Way Home Kamloops, Katherine McParland, along with the previous franchise owner of Kamloops Domino's began Campout. Last year's Campout took place one week after the passing of Katherine McParland, making this the second year without our beloved friend and champion of youth. We will be marking both our 5th year of Campout and the 1-year memorial of Katherine's passing. At this year's Campout, we wish to celebrate her legacy and the work she started while continuing our efforts to make Katherine's dreams a reality. The event will include presentations from sponsors, campers, and youth with lived expertise. Presentations will include a memorial for Katherine, ensuring her voice and legacy where youth are heard and valued carries on.

This year's event takes place Friday, December 10th to Saturday December 11th. Campers will have the option of receiving Campout packages and being supported to find their own way of camping at home. There will be activities hosted over Zoom throughout the night. Campers can receive Campout signage to display on their lawns. All BC CDC protocols will be followed.



Last year, we had campers join from the storefronts of their businesses, backyards, front porches, balconies, cars, and even from their living rooms with their kids. Katherine's Place



Youth homelessness is a significant issue, exacerbated due to COVID-19, making already difficult to navigate systems even more difficult to access. Every night in Kamloops, young people without a stable home search for somewhere safe to stay. The pandemic has emphasized situations such as aging out of care or abuse, where a youth is homeless through no fault of their own. The longer a youth is homeless, the more trauma and victimization they experience. With current unprecedented challenges, youth need a home now more than ever!

This year's donations go toward A Way Home Kamloops new building, Katherine's Place. It will have 39 units with 24/7 staff support for youth ages 19-26 and will include programs to develop critical life skills while working towards their employment and educational goals.
